 - In blue zone cars need to pull all the way up to the sign rather than stop and block the road or the crosswalk
- Enforcement of not texting and driving is needed, especially at the corner of Parkview and Cabot streets as per crossing guard
 - crossing guard spoke
 - problem at the crosswalk when turning right at the signal of the crossing guard from Parkside onto Cabot street; drivers texting at the stop and not looking up to see signal/instructions from the crossing guard

 - Last year the city did a poor job salting and with snow removal
 - Annette / Allie Cabot reps for Safe Routes to School; meet monthly; law enforcement attends
